I, William C. Jung, do hereby certify that on the 24th day of April 1984, I found (evidence) ~~no evidence~~ of the East 1/4 corner of Section 10, T15 N, R 1 E Fourth Principal Meridian, and I re-established said corner according to the Wisconsin Statutes as shown and described hereon.

History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

Dahl started a road job from this corner in July of 1868. Harley Sime found an iron pipe at this corner in July of 1964 and used it as the corner. In 1979 James Carroll used this corner as a tie point in three surveys, including "Palamaruk Addition". In 1981 Larry Feddersen tied to this corner when surveying in Section 15.

Description of corner evidence found:

I found an iron pipe at the occupied fence corner and accepted it as the best available evidence of the original government corner. I feel that the white oak to the NW is an original. The distance fits very well, but the bearing does not. I looked to the NE of the corner but found nothing. I found another iron marker about 18" to the West of the pipe. I removed the pipe and replaced it with a Harrison marker. Feddersen's distance to the section corner to the South was about 2635 feet which fits the original distance very well.


Description of corner and witness monuments, references and accessories used to perpetuate the original or re-established location of this corner:

This old white oak has a girth of about 7.5 feet. I believe that it is an original bearing tree. There appears to be a scar low on the Southeast corner. I did not blaze the tree.

12" white oak single blazed


18" unblazed hickory
