History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

O. R. Dahl was at this corner in December of 1868. Holden found the original corner here in November of 1907. Apparently he set an iron pipe here as shown in some unrecorded field notes.

Description of corner evidence found:

I dug and searched but could not find Holden's iron. I set the corner on line with Holden's iron pipe at the E1/16SE and the fence corner at the NE Corner, and at a distance from the E1/16SE equal to 1/3 of the distance between the E1/16SE and the NE Corners. The road centerline to the North is thus almost perfectly on the section line as it should be according to the old Town Road Records. This location also fits other evidence in all (4) cardinal directions very well.





