History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

Holden found the original corner here in November of 1907. Apparently he set an iron here as shown in some unrecorded field notes. Town Board Records indicate that the centerline of the road to the South was to have been on the section line.




Description of corner evidence found:

I could not find an iron at this corner. I did find Holden's pipe, down 6", at the E1/16SE corner of Section 18. I set the 1/4 corner on line and proportionately between this latter pipe and the fence corner at the NE of Section 18. For alignment and distance, this fits conditions along the East line of Section 18 very well.
