

Description of corner evidence found:

A railroad spike of unknown origin was found at this corner location by Owen Ayres & Asso. in September, 1977 and was to be replaced with a 1 1/4" round iron bar by that office. The railroad spike had not been replaced with the bar at the time of our survey. We do not know if the stone of record had been excavated for previously. We accepted the location of the railroad spike and placed a Harrison at that location.


