I, Harley A. Sime, do hereby certify that on the fourth day of June 1980, I found (evidence) (~~no evidence~~) of the Southwest corner of Section 14, T 18 N, R 1 E Fourth Principal Meridian, and I re-established said corner according to the Wisconsin Statutes as shown and described hereon.

History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

Schroeder (?) was at this corner in December of 1889. Harley Sime set an iron pipe at this corner in 1960. He again used this corner in 1961. Feddersen used this iron pipe in May of 1976 and July of 1979. Malliet used this pipe in a September, 1977 survey.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a pipe used in previous survey work, removed it and replaced it with a Harrison. This location fits the old occupied line and also falls at the location as shown on the 1910 railroad R/W map.



