History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

Schroeder (?) reset this corner in December of 1889. Ray Hurlburt found a bolt at this corner in October of 1940 and set another bolt next to the existing one. Mulock found a bolt at this corner in his surveys of June and August, 1967. Fedderson set a 1 1/4" iron bar on top of an existing bolt in May of 1976. Malliet used Description of corner evidence found: this corner in his September 1977 survey.





Removed a 1 1/4" x 30" iron bar and replaced it with a Harrison monument, set down 6"±. Harrison is set over a large metal object.
