I, William C. Jung, do hereby certify that on the 27th day of July 1978, I found (evidence) (no evidence) of the NW corner of Section 22, T15 N, R2 W, Fourth Principal Meridian, and I re-established said corner according to the Wisconsin Statutes as shown and described hereon.

History of original corner establishment:

Webster Kenyon was here in Dec. of 1891.

Description of corner evidence found:

Aerial photo and field evidence show that this corner may be too far North. However, I measured back 260'+ from the creek, and then measured over and found an old oak. I believe this to be Kenyon's tree from 1891. Measured back from the tree and set the corner South of the fence. This fits the original notes distance back to the creek. If one studies the aerial photo, you can see that the line takes a drastic bend at this point. Accepted what I believe to be the old corner location, right or wrong.





