I, William C. Jung, do hereby certify that on the 19th day of April 1984, I found ~~(evidence) no evidence~~ of the South 1/4 corner of Section 31, T 15 N, R 2 W Fourth Principal Meridian, and I re-established said corner according to the Wisconsin Statutes as shown and described hereon.

History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

Vernon County records show a surveyor at this corner in May of 1873. Wm. Knower, Vernon County Surveyor, shows this corner in a survey done in April of 1878. Knower was again at this corner in a survey done in February of 1882. The Monroe County records show that a surveyor was at this corner in March of 1898 and found a large stake surrounded by stones. Schroeder and/or LaRue from the Monroe County Surveyor's office in November of 1899 found an old post surrounded by stones that had been known and regarded by old settlers for 35 years as the true 1/4 corner.




After surveying out the Town & County Line going East-West, and surveying out part of Section 6-T14N-R2W, I accepted the occupied fence corner as the best available evidence of the original government corner, of LaRue's corner, and also Knower's corner. This fits very well by distance the original government distances going East-West and also the East-West occupation. The distance South to the occupied C1/4 of Section 6 fits Knowers distance within 0.9 ft.!
