
Description of corner evidence found:

Found an unrecorded iron pipe and accepted it as it fits occupied fences. Also may have found an original bearing tree. The original notes call for a 7" Black Oak. NIOE. 124 lks. We found a 28" Green Ash which fits this bearing and distance from the existing iron pipe. It is possible that this may be the original tree if the original surveyors confused there trees which could be the case as the original survey was done in the fall of 1847. Green Ash and Black Oak do look somewhat alike in the fall after the leaves drop.
