Kenyon (?) was at this corner in April of 1883. Fred Holden found Kenyon's stake at this corner in November of 1899 and April of 1900.

Accepted the occupied fence corner as the best available evidence of the original government corner. This location agrees with other evidence found in the NE1/4 of Section 14. Set the top 1/2 of a Harrison marker.




