History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey

H. A. Sime was here in April of 1970 and set a nail. In his survey of June, 1971, Duane Marten shows a 3/4" iron bar at this corner.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 3/4" iron bar. Removed and set a Harrison Marker, flush with pavement. Accepted the corner at the occupied corner as the best available evidence of the original government survey.

UPDATE: The Highway Commissioner for Monroe County informed the County Surveyor's Office that C.T.H. "M" would be resurfaced. The Section and Quarter corners along this stretch were removed. Following resurfacing the corners were replaced. The new corner is shown below along with updated ties.


Description of corner and witness monuments, references and accessories used to perpetuate the original or re-established location of this corner:



