

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER

History of corner established since Original Government Survey

In April of 1902 Fred Holden shows a 2 inch pipe at this corner. In June of 1976 William Jung found a pipe used in previous surveys, accepted it, and replaced it with a Harrison monument.

Description of evidence found

On September 12th, 2012, Anderson Engineering of Minnesota located the Harrison monument 0.4 feet below grade and 1 foot south of a metal post with survey marker sign.

Marker is flush with ground.


