In November of 1903, Fred Holden resurveyed Section 12, T18N, R1W, Town of La Grange, and set a 'stake'. Since that time improvements such as a good asphalt road have occurred possibly wiping out this 'stake'. Occupation lines And improvements testify to the existing iron bar found in its place.

Description of corner evidence found:




