Fred Holden was at this corner in April of 1902.

Description of corner evidence found:

I found two old stunted white oaks which I believe are Holden's old bearing trees. Measuring back from them puts me in the old fence intersection. My measurement from this corner to the E1/16SE (where I found two of Holden's bearing trees) checks very well with my alignment and measurement between the E1/16SE and the S.E. corner. Monumented this corner with a Harrison marker.




