The 1940's McCoy boundary notes show a corner at this location. On November 15th, 1982, William C. Jung found a McCoy boundary marker and accepted it as the corner.

August 7th, 2012, Anderson Engineering of Minnesota located the McCoy monument, a 4 inch U.S. Army Corps of Engineers survey control mark disk set in concrete 1 foot above grade and 1.25 feet northeast of a witness post with a sign.
