Holden said there was a stone here in June, 1908.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found existing stone, down 45" and an old stump that appears to be Holdens old bearing tree.

UPDATE: While working on a survey for Mr. Hill to the East, I found that this corner was lacking good quality ties. I found the Harrison down 6"± and in good conition. Established new ties and checked to old ones as shown below.







Description of corner and witness monuments, references and accessories used to perpetuate the original or re-established location of this corner:
