

County Surveyor C.M. Keach, in County Survey Record No. 397 made in 1902 and recorded in Vol. 2 at page 142 states, "Found W. Oak N 34 E 314 and stake at corner. Set stone 20x 8 x 8 at corner."

Keith H. Bennett, in a survey for Jackson Co. Forestry Dept. made in 1941 and recorded in Vol. 14 at p. 15 states, "Iron pipe in mound with stone from former survey. Pits E & W in marsh."

We drove Bennett's pipe down to about flush. No trees other than poplar (aspen) near for reference.
