


PLAT OF SURVEY-

DESCRIPTION:

**PART OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 AND PART OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 IN SECTION 16,
T15N, R1W, TOWN OF WELLINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, WISCONSIN.**

The following description is part of the east property line of the above named forties:

Commencing at the W1/4 corner of said Section 16, thence along the north line of the SW1/4 in said Section 16 bearing S89-39-14E, 1256.08 feet, to forty corner; thence along said east property line bearing S00-35-41W, 1072.32 feet, to the centerline of Millstone Avenue, being the point of beginning. Thence continued along said east property line bearing S00-35-41W, 1580.02 feet, to forty corner, being the point of termination.
