





NOTE: 1" Iron Pipes near 16' alley appear to be 3.28' South.




Mr. Peterson, longtime owner of Lot 3, states the deck is built upon the foundation of the former garage location, with the property line being inches to the North. The present owner of Lot 5 does not believe there is any encroachment. The measurements taken from the buried iron pipes seem to bear this out, and represent the most viable locations of the property lines.
