




**DESCRIPTION:**

A parcel of land located in the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 16-T16N-R1W, Town of Wilton, Monroe County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at an existing 3/4" iron bar at the occupied West 1/4 corner of said Section 16; thence N82°56'24"E, 1701.31 feet to a point on the Northwesterly right-of-way line of C.T.H. "MM", said point being the point of beginning; thence N48°52'01"E, 408.81 feet along the Northwesterly right-of-way line of said highway; thence N68°00'E, 224.66 feet along said right-of-way line; thence N40°17'05"W, 828.78 feet; thence S32°39'16"W, 643.81 feet; thence S39°37'36"E, 575.49 feet to the point of beginning, containing 9.63 acres of land, more or less. (The area of said parcel with the road right-of-way included is 10.1 acres, more or less.) The bearings of said parcel are magnetic.

- = Set 5/8"x24" iron bar weighing 1.15 lbs./lin. ft.
- = Found a 3/4" iron bar by an old post, 3 ft. North and 1.5 ft. East of the fence corner. This bar is the same as the one as shown on Marten's C.S.M. of July 12, 1972, Monroe County Document No. 308757.
