


MAP OF SURVEY

The north line of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ -NE $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 6, T19N, R3W, Town of New Lyme, Monroe County, Wisconsin, for Randy Heimke and Mike Wilkens



BEARINGS in this survey are based on the North line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 6, which is assumed to bear N88°51'34"E, as shown on a previous survey.
