MAP OF SURVEY


A part of FL 1, Sec. 1, T19N, R5W, Town of Melrose, Jackson County, and a part of FL 1 Sec. 6, T19N, R4W, Town of Little Falls, Monroe County, Wisconsin, for Duane & Julie Gerdes

Bearings in this survey are based on the North line of Fractional Lot 1, which is assumed to bear North 89°07'03" West as used in CSR 2531.

NOTE: The solid line shown on this map is only a part of a proposed boundary. The intended boundary will extend west to the west line of Fractional Lot 1 and east to the Black River according to a legal description prepared by me for property transfer to be completed in April 1998. The westerly pipe set in this survey is on the line of power poles, near the east right of way line of Horseshoe Road. The easterly pipe is into the edge of woods east of open field.



SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Norman R. Hurlburt, Registered Land Surveyor, hereby certify that, by the order and under the direction of Duane & Julie Gerdes, I have surveyed and mapped a line in Fractional Lot 1 of Section 1 in Township 19 North of Range 5 West, Town of Melrose, Jackson County, and Fractional Lot 1 of Section 6 in Township 19 North of Range 4 West, Town of Little Falls, Monroe County, Wisconsin, described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Fractional Lot 1 of Section 1; thence South 2° 12' 30" East 660.96 feet, to a point which is 660.00 feet south of the north line of said Fractional Lot 1, as measured at right angles thereto, and the point of beginning; thence South 89° 07' 03" East 1868.47 feet, and there terminating.
