




ASSUMED NORTH


Bearings referenced to the East line of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 26, T19N-R4W, assumed to bear N0°02'20"W.

DESCRIPTION:


A parcel of land located in the NE 1/4-SE 1/4 of Section 26, T19N-R4W, Town of Little Falls, Monroe County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at the SE corner of said Section 26; thence N0°02'20"W along the East line of said SE 1/4, 1366.74 feet; thence West 322.42 feet to the Northerly line of C.T.H. "I" and also being the point of beginning; thence S65°19'25"W along the Northerly line of said C.T.H. "I", 34.40 feet; thence N8°14'25"W, 335.20 feet; thence S80°57'W, 157.00 feet; thence N8°14'25"W, 285.00 feet; thence N80°57'E, 190.00 feet; thence S8°14'25"E, 610.94 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 1.49 acre of land. Subject to powerline easement.
