


SURVEY MAP

Survey for Sigurd Jacobson to locate, monument and describe the boundaries of a parcel of land in the NW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Sec. 34 - T 19 N - R 4 W in Monroe County, Wis.

Completed July 1965.

Since there was no record of monumentation of corners on the Section line East of this parcel and the land was rough and heavily wooded I decided to base this survey on the prolongation of a line over points A & B indicated on the above map. I do not assume responsibility for this being the true or legal section line. My client, the owner, was so informed.

- A - N ¼ sec. cor. - an old well known corner but rather poorly monumented with a 3/8 x 13 in. round head iron rod, down about 6 in., in street. 38.8 ft. SEly from corner of old frame blacksmith shop and 35.5 ft. NWly from NW cor. of concrete block tavern building.
- B - 1 ¼ in. iron pipe used and indicated on survey map of new Cataract School lot by Harley Sime, County Surveyor, Monroe County. This pipe is North of the center line of the street or County road as now paved. I found it slightly above the surface but drove it down about 3 in.
- C - Point of intersection of apparent mean center line of road South Easterly as far as I could see with assumed Section line. I did not learn of any monumentation to define right of way line. Present pavement bears a little North Westerly from this line for several hundred feet before it approaches the curve. Location of assumed right of way was satisfactory with client. I drove a 1 x 26 in. iron pipe, flush, at this point.
- D & E - I drove 1 x about 26 in. iron pipes, up about 4 in. as indicated on assumed right of way line.
- F & G - I drove 1 x about 26 in. pipes, up 6 in., on line parallel and 200 feet from assumed center line as indicated.

I hereby certify that the above map and field notes of this survey, together with my statements relating to the records of former surveys in this area, are correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
