1. Monitor health status to identify community health problems.
2. Identify, investigate, control, and prevent health problems and environmental health hazards in the community.
3. Inform, educate, and empower the public about current and emerging health issues.
4. Promote community partnerships to identify and solve health problems.
5. Develop policies and plans that support individual and community health efforts.
6. Enforce laws and regulations that protect health and ensure safety.
7. Link people to needed health services.
8. Assure a diverse, adequate, and competent workforce to support the public health system.
9. Evaluate effectiveness, accessibility, and quality of personal and population-based health system.
10. Assure access to primary health care for all.
11. Foster the understanding and promotion of social and economic conditions that support good health.
12. Conduct research to seek new insights and innovative solutions to health problems.
