1. Call to order/Roll call. *At 12:33 PM.*
2. ***Motion by Al Hoff to approve August 7th, 2018 Minutes. Seconded by Sharon Folcey. All in favor. Motion Carried.***
3. Update on Land Information Office activities in brief. Dominated by post flood related documentation and mapping for Emergency Management and post flood questions. Time was also spent on Survey123 related tasks working with the Highway Department. Mapping locations under Chapter 980 of Wisconsin Statutes for use in Sexually Violent Persons placement. Addressing really slowed down after the flooding. Changes to addressing process were minimal.
4. Highlighted changes to 2018 grant which focused on covering Survey Equipment, few section corners and more time working with acquired section corner data. ***Motion by Al Hoff to approve the 2018 WLIP Grant Re-write, Seconded by Brannick Beatse, All in favor. Motion Carried.***
5. Changes and updates to the new Land Information Plan were noted. The main focus aside from general updates were new projects that we plan on undertaking in the next three years. Acquisition of LiDAR, Aerial imagery and a new server for ESRI software and the current Register of Deeds software transition currently underway. ***Motion by Deb Brandy to approve the 2019-2021 Land Information Plan, Seconded by Gary Dechant, All in favor. Motion Carried.***
6. The focus of the 2019 grant will be LiDAR acquisition. The rest of the typical software expenses and website subscription fees remain as in years past. A trip to the Annual WLIA meeting is included as well. ***Motion by John Mehtala to approve the 2019 WLIP Grant Application, Seconded by Brannick, All in favor, Motion Carried.***
7. Register of Deeds update on Fidar Software Installation. Deb Brandt stated that they will be going live on December 3<sup>rd</sup>. IS department will install equipment next week. Fidar will be on hand on the 3<sup>rd</sup>. Tuesday December 4<sup>th</sup> Department Heads can train at 1PM in the Great Hall. Wednesday December 5<sup>th</sup> at 9AM and 1PM there will be training for the public. Images are available back to 1935. Grantor/Grantee index is back to 1974. Tract Index information is now available back to 1992.
8. Zuercher Software was included in the final budget for Dispatch with a plan to go live Jan 1, 2020.
9. ***Motion by Brannick Beatse to revise the Land Information Fee Schedule. Second by Sharon Folcey, All in Favor, Motion Carried.***
10. Items on the next agenda may included Zuercher Software, LiDAR and ArcGIS.
11. Next meeting may take place on March 12<sup>th</sup> at 1:00PM.
