## History of corner established since Original Government Survey

The 1940's McCoy boundary notes show a corner at this location. Maxwell used this corner in 1997, Vol. 11 CSM 114. Sime utilized this corner in 2002, Vol. 16 CSM 63.

## Description of evidence found

On September 25th, 2012, Anderson Engineering of Minnesota located the McCoy monument, a 4 inch U.S. Army Corps of Engineers survey control mark disk set in concrete 1.0 foot above grade.



