

Legal Description For Proposed Exchange:

T. 19N., R. 1E., Fourth Principal Meridian, Monroe County, WI

In section thirty-three (33), that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) described as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of said section thirty-three (33); thence S86°24'05"E, along the south line of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), 292.70 feet to the easterly right-of-way of State Highway No. 173 and the **POINT OF BEGINNING**; thence N40°10'20"E, along said easterly right-of-way, 377.12 feet; thence S86°24'05"E, parallel with said south line, 431.49 feet; thence S40°10'20"W, parallel with said easterly right-of-way, 377.12 feet to said south line; thence N86°24'05"W, along said south line, 431.49 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**. Containing 3.00 acres.
