History of corner establishment since Original Government Survey
A.S. Ingalls was at this corner in April of 1873. Fred Holden set a stone at this corner in May of 1902. Harley Sime found this stone in the Spring of 1963. He again used this stone in a Sept., 1965 survey. Duane Marten used this corner in a June, 1973 survey. Larry Feddersen used this stone in surveys of December, 1978 and May, 1979.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found the stone of record. Set a Harrison monument South of the stone as a witness monument.


