The meeting was called to order at the Monroe County Board Assembly Room at 9:01 a.m. by Chair Ron Luethe

Introductions: Name/Title

Advisory Members 5 Minute Reports:

ITBEC- Nodji VanWychen: No monthly meeting held in July, no updates. Next meeting 1<sup>st</sup> Friday in August, location TBD

Local History Room- Jarrod Roll: Opening doors to the public today by reservation only. Partnered with Kiwanis Club for a Scavenger Hunt on August 1<sup>st</sup> 2020. Building updates completed.

Fort McCoy- Tonya Townsell: Social Media Post has been shown backlash. Started a Diversity council already. Race + Racism speech at Tomah School today. Brett and Heidi both attending. Covid-19 Testing and 14 day quarantine at Challenge academy. Training held in mid-July to August will increase population and vehicles.
